New Chair Elected to Skills Center Advisory Board

The General Advisory Council is mandated by state regulation to perform as a program advisory council to Skills Center Director Dennis Kampe offering workplace, education and community perspective on the 15 programs provided by the Skills Center.

Council members represent member school districts, colleges, Educational School District 112, the State Legislature, the Southwest Washington Workforce Development Council, the State department of Labor and Industries, the community at large, local business and industry, Skills Center parents and Skills Center staff.

The Skills Center opened in 1983. Located in east Vancouver at 12200 NE 28th Street, it is owned and operated by ten southwest Washington school districts to provide technical and professional training programs to prepare Clark County high school and college students for the workforce.
