Hours / Attendance:

- 1600 hours (in the above areas of study) are needed to qualify for the Washington State Cosmetology License. Excellent attendance is mandatory to ensure hours needed are gained before graduation. Should those hours not be attained for whatever reason, students will be able to transfer their hours to a post-secondary Cosmetology school in the area upon graduation from high school. If a student cannot attend class, they need to call the attendance line at 360-604-1077 to excuse their absence. This must be done within 30 minutes of the start of their session time. An automatic call will be made home for all absences, excused or unexcused to keep parents informed.
- Students gain 3 high school credits for the 1st year.
