

Dental Year 1 Program Supply List / Student Costs:

Dental Uniform and Other Requirements

- Dental Uniform – One set approximately \$70 includes tax (CASH only) includes one scrub top and bottom, one elite patch and one pair of shoes. A fitting date with the company, Dress Code, will be announced at Parent/Student Orientation and will be held in June. If you miss the first fitting date, Dress Code, will be in the classroom the first week of school for uniform fittings and ordering.
- White Socks (clinic)
- Closed toed shoes included in uniform cost, must be worn in the classroom (open toed, flip flops, Birkenstock's, sandals not allowed for safety purposes).
- OSHA approved safety glasses. If student alternates between contacts and prescription glasses, student will need two pairs of safety glasses (one regular pair and one that goes over glasses).
- American Heart Association BLS (Healthcare level) CPR and First Aid approximately \$45: CPR will be held on pre-arranged Saturday's and Sunday's, not in class (each student will attend one day to complete class). Deadline date to be announced at Orientation; if fee not paid by set deadline date, student will be responsible for obtaining own BLS, First Aid at one of the local facilities that offer it, e.g., NW Regional Training Center \$112.25 (total) or Red Cross \$145 (total).
- **Documentation of current immunization records.** Immunizations are requested to be completed *prior* to students starting the Dental program. The immunization record may be completed by one of the following: your family physician, your health care provider or by the Department of Health. You are required to bring a copy of your completed immunization record the first week of school. **Immunizations include: Adacel** (DTaP, Diphtheria, tetanus and acellular pertussis vaccine is MANDATORY no matter when you have received your last tetanus booster), **MMR** (Students must provide proof of 2 MMR vaccines after age 1 year), **Hepatitis B** (series of 3 injections must be completed prior to participating in lab activities or contact with patients in clinical training courses), and an **annual PPD Tuberculin Skin test** (History of BCG vaccination is not a contraindication for PPD testing). The program needs a note from your physician clearing you of TB (results of whatever test was applied) prior to any student to student contact in lab or student to patient contact in clinic.
- Flu vaccine/H1N1 vaccine is optional, but highly suggested as students will be having direct contact with members of the community. The flu vaccine is recommended for all healthcare workers.
- Family medical insurance or student accident insurance is required. Students not covered by medical insurance will not be allowed to participate in clinic or lab activities until insurance is obtained. Students will need to provide copies of health insurance coverage.

Note: *Student accident insurance is available through your sending high school.*

- 1-2 - ANYCOLOR <2"> 3-ring binder (used for handouts, assignments, competencies)
- 1 – WHITE or BLACK <1"> 3-ring binder (used for portfolio at mock interview time)
- 1 – pkg 10 sheet protectors (used with portfolio, will need more at end of year for certificates to be placed in portfolio)
- 2 – pencil box – hard plastic (one for general lab materials / supplies & one for personal pens/pencils)
- 2 – multi-colored pens (RED/BLUE/BLACK)
- 2 – pkgs colored markers (eight or more markers, 1-set thin and 1-set thick)
- 1 – Tri-board poster (for cultural project) *may need additional if choosing to use this format for professional development project
- 1- pkg paper (college or wide ruled)
- 1 – pkg (48) Thank you Notes (used for all guests speakers, providers, and volunteers)
- Writing utensils (pencils, black or blue ink pens, highlighters-yellow, pink, and blue)
- 1 – Black Sharpie
- 1 – box sandwich baggies (zip kind)
- 1 – container dental floss (waxed)
- 1 – USB /Thumb Drive (resumes, cover letters, presentations, etc.)
- 1 – Pkg Hair Ties, clips and pins (hair off-shoulders and out of eyes)
- 1 – Composition Notebook (clinic notebook, set-ups and reflections)
- 1 – Package index cards (flash cards)
- 1 – Package post-it notes – Yellow color
- 1 – Personal planner / calendar
- 1 – Container hand sanitizer
- 1 – Pkg Super Glue
- 1 – Clipboard
- 1 – Container perfume free, waterbased (not petroleum based) lotion
- 1 – Email address (student 1st and last name within email, can be one from school, gmail, yahoo, or aol)
- 1 – Box Tissue
- 1 – Container antibacterial wipes
- 1 – Lanyard with plastic cover for name badge
- White Socks (must be worn daily)
