

Dental Year 2 Program Supply List / Student Costs:

- Dental II Program total fees of \$15 payable by check to CTA or cash DUE the first week of school covers: WA HOSA dues and membership (Future Health Professionals formerly known as Health Occupations Students of America). If student competing for State or National there are additional competition fees, travel and hotel fees.
- REQUIRED – Fees paid to other vendors: Uniform ordered through Dress Code - Fitting for Dental II uniform in CTA Dental classroom first week of school (cash only paid to Dress Code due at fitting, approximately \$75).
- Vaccines/Tests: We have vaccines on file from the previous year. Second Year Dental students will need an annual TB skin test: PPD (Tuberculosis Screening - History of BCG vaccination is not a contraindication for PPD testing).
- Optional/Highly Suggested: Flu Vaccine / H1N1 vaccine – students will be having direct contact with members of the community, the flu vaccine is recommended for all health care workers

OPTIONAL – Fees Paid to other Vendors

- Dental Assistant Registration: \$40 Payable to Washington State Department of Health: registration required to work in a dental office in the state of WA *must be renewed annually for \$21. ** Department of Health may require student to be 18 years of age to register and background check with the state is required. Note: There are additional costs that occur when applying for the Dental Assistant Registration and the National Certifications
- American Dental Assistants Association Student Membership: \$35, add \$10 for professional liability insurance
- Program Sweatshirt: Price varies by style \$30 - \$50, ordered online
- Students successfully completing Dental I and II are eligible to apply for 2/3rd of the Dental Assisting National Boards, CDA, (DANB) examination, Oregon Radiology Certificate, Oregon Expanded Functions Certificate

- 1 – Pkg 10 sheet protectors (used with portfolio, will need more at end of year for certificates to be placed in portfolio)
- 2 – Pencil boxes – hard plastic (one for general lab materials / Supplies & one for personal lab materials / supplies)
- 2 – Multi-colored pens (Red/Blue/Black)
- 1 – Pkg colored markers or colored pencils (eight or more colors)
- 1 – Tri-board Poster (for cultural project) *may need additional if choosing to use this format for professional development project
